Our approach follows the four hallmarks of advanced literacy instruction (Lesaux et al., 2016), fostering learning through engaging content, meaningful discussion, frequent writing, and vocabulary study. Coaches collaborate with teachers to refine their instructional methods and devise effective shared curriculum.

Using a CR-SE framework, we assist in instruction, curriculum design, assessment, and collaborative inquiry. We empower teachers with actionable steps to strengthen the reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills of their students.

Building an inclusive classroom environment is paramount to our work. We incorporate strategies for building and sustaining relationships around the identity, culture, history, and lived experiences of learners.

Ensuring that students have competent literacy skills is essential. This ability to understand complex text is critical for work force participation.


Our Impact

Our Results

During the course of the 2021-2022 school year, we implemented Literacy Matters in 16 schools. 62% of students were on grade level when their schools participated in Literacy Matters — 12% higher than the NWEA National Average.
